## Determinative Criteria for Discipline-Neutral and Discipline-Focused Incident Management Teams

- The figures illustrate how discipline-focused incident management teams (IMTs) and their endorsements affect discipline-neutral incident management team deployments, and how the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), National Qualifications System (NQS), and the All-Hazards Incident Management Teams Association (AHIMTA), Model Qualifications System (MQS) position requirements affect a discipline-focused IMT on discipline-neutral deployments.
- 2) Figure 1 shows an IMT whose members have completed their ICS position qualifications using the NIMS NQS or the AHIMTA MQS position qualifications requirements. These teams are referred to as either an All-Hazards or Discipline-Neutral Incident Management Team and use the abbreviation (AHIMT).<sup>1</sup>
- 3) Figures 2 and 3 show IMTs whose members have completed their ICS position qualifications using a *discipline-focused qualification system* that does NOT include the criteria stated in paragraph 2. These teams are referred to as discipline-focused IMTs.
